Code of Conduct

We are a group volunteers and have set aside our personal time to work for the community.

We will:

- serve the community with dignity, courtesy and respect.
- be available through agreed methods of communication i.e. attendance at monthly Community Council meetings or by e-mail to riversidecommunitycouncil@gmail.com.
- expect that residents treat us with dignity, courtesy and respect.

We will not accept:

- behaviour which is offensive, rude, intimidating, demeaning or threatening.
- demands that are beyond the scope of the Community Council.

Response to unacceptable behaviour:

- 1. Politely explain that we should be treated with respect and ask the resident to moderate their behaviour.
- 2. If the behaviour continues the resident will be advised that the interaction will end and that other Community Councillors will be informed.
- 3. If behaviour threatens violence or is violent, we will immediately stop interacting with the resident, ensure we are safe and contact Police Scotland.
- 4. We will cease working with individual/s who regularly engage with us in a confrontational or unacceptable way. This action can be reviewed if/when required.
- 5. We reserve the right to walk away, end a phone call or ask someone to leave a meeting (in person or online).

This statement applies to both verbal and written communications and is backed up by a fuller policy statement written by Stirling Council
