

Social Media - Acceptable Use Policy

Riverside Community Council invites people to visit our website and engage with our Facebook page. In tandem with our code of conduct (found here) this policy is to support us with our interactions with members of the public by establishing the behaviours that are considered acceptable.

To ensure the safe and productive use of all our digital platforms and communications we ask that you we ask you not to post messages that could be considered to be any of the following:

- abusive, harassing, harmful
- defamatory or libellous
- containing swearing or obscenities
- discriminatory
- unlawful

We ask that

- you do not post content copied from elsewhere, for which you do not own the copyright.
- you do not post the same or similar messages more than once (also known as "spamming").
- you do not publicise your, or anyone else's, personal information in compliance with GDPR requirements. Our policy can be found here.
- you do not advertise your own or other products or services.
- you do not pretend to be someone else.
- you refrain from political statements and endorsements we are a politically neutral organisation.
