## Dear Friends

We want to let you know that works for the Causewayhead and Dunster Road sections of Walk, Cycle, Live Stirling will be commencing on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> August for a 10 week period. The works will be carried out in four construction phases; with Phase 1 Causewayhead Road commencing on Mon 1<sup>st</sup> August. Initially the works will start at 8.00am until 17.00pm, however times may be subject to change at short notice. The Roads Team will liaise closely residents /businesses as the works commence/progress to minimise disruption where possible.

<u>Phases 1, 2 & 4</u> will where possible allow two way traffic flows to be maintained along Causewayhead Rd and Airthrey Rd, however where safe working zones cannot be achieved two way traffic lights will be operational.


<u>Phase 3</u> – Dumyat Rd /Dunster Rd will be assessed and appropriate traffic management measures will be implemented. Pedestrian and cyclists movements will be restricted with barriers and signage in place to allow the users to pass the works safely.

## What is involved?

- The existing footpaths will be widened to accommodate the inclusion of a new cycleway.
- The existing whin kerbs will be excavated and re-laid to suit the proposed design /layout.
- New footpath/cycleway, roadside drainage, traffic signals / pedestrian crossings and landscaping will be installed to suit the proposed design within each phase.
- The footpath and cycle-ways including the main Causewayhead Road / Airthrey Rd and Dunster Rd will be resurfaced where required. (Any road closure requirements will be notifiable in advance of resurfacing the main carriageways).
- New signage / road-markings will be installed as per the proposed design /layout.


Temporary signage will be erected; the working areas will be cordoned off to suit each work activity; this will allow the works to be carried out a safe and efficient manner. Road users and pedestrians should adhere to the signage throughout the works, please drive with extra care when navigating in and around the works.

Phase 2 - Causewayhead Road - Dunster Road to Causewayhead RA.

<u>Phase 3 - Dunster Road - Dumyat Road to Airthrey Road.</u> <u>Phase 4 - A9 Airthrey Rd form Causewayhead RA to Wallace High School</u>



The site office and welfare facilities will be located within the existing carpark area within Aboyne Ave. Please note that Aboyne Avenue will be limited access to residents and site traffic only.

The commencement dates for the above phases will follow on in due course.
